One (1) flush toilet and one (1) adjacent handwashing facility with running water available for every twenty (20) children. Urinals may be substituted for up to one-half (1/2) the required number of toilets, with a minimum of one (1) toilet per bathroom.

CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The reporter called the Section for Child Care office on April 08, 2021, and inquired about the regulations in relation to having the water shut off on April 9 at Faith Academy Early Childhood. The reporter stated that the director of the child care center stated that the water was going to be off that day, although the facility will still be operating. On April 09, 2021, Child Care Facility Specialist (CCFS) Marla Chrisco conducted an investigation and found the allegation to be substantiated. The following rule was violated:

19 CSR 30-60.100 (3)(A): One (1) flush toilet and one (1) adjacent handwashing facility with running water available for every twenty (20) children. Urinals may be substituted for up to one-half (1/2) the required number of toilets, with a minimum of one (1) toilet per bathroom.

On April 09, 2021, CCFS Marla Chrisco conducted an interview with facility director, Kristin Skebo who provided information that the facility's water was turned off at 9:00 a.m. on Friday April 09, 2021, so before 9:00 a.m., the facility staff made all the meals and snacks ahead of time and filled up water coolers and jugs with water to use for drinking and hand washing and the staff and children used the toilets but they could not flush them until the water came back on at about 1:00 p.m. on April 09, 2021.

On April 09, 2021, CCFS Marla Chrisco, observed the sinks and toilets in the facility at about 1:10 p.m. on April 09, 2021 and they were all in working order.

The reporter was anonymous so therefore could not be interviewed.
