CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Section for Child Care Regulation (SCCR) determined the facility violated this licensing rule on May 10, 2021 based on interviews with the facility director, Tiffany Myers, staff, Joyce Reese, Jazmon Elliott, and observation from CCFS Alison Evans. Director, Tiffany Myers and staff Joyce Reese, stated that on May 10, 2021 that Joyce Reece did not notify Parents of Child A of the incident when Child A fell off the steps to the slide in the infant/toddler room and did not fill out an incident/accident report. CCFS, Alison Evans observed video footage on May 21, 2021 of the incident on May 10, 2021 with Child A falling off the step to the slide in the infant/toddler room. Also while viewing the footage caregiver, Joyce Reese was standing in the doorway of the infant/toddler room with her back to the children for approximately three to five minutes. The children were unsupervised for approximately three to five minutes. The video footage was viewed by CCFS Evans for five minutes.
