CONCLUSION SUMMARY

This allegation is found to be substantiated based on the interviews with Lena Hammond, Daphne Vance, and Sandra Eagleburger. Lena Hammond and Daphne Vance reported they had served scrambled eggs, raisin toast and milk for breakfast on December 5, 2018. CCFS Hohensee observed the menu board at the front of the center stated the children had had scrambled eggs and cinnamon raisin toast. All staff members interviewed reported parents are allowed to bring in additional breakfast food for the children to eat at the facility and were not aware that this was in violation of the Section for Child Care Regulation (SCCR) policy. SCCR determined the facility did not provide a breakfast service that was in compliance with licensing rules on December 5, 2018.
