19 CSR 30-62.092 (1)(B)(2)(G)

Cribs, portable cribs and playpens shall be free of soft objects, loose bedding or any object that can increase the risk of entrapment, suffocation or strangulation. Examples include bumper pads, pillows, quilts, comforters, sleep positioning devices, sheepskins, blankets, flat sheets, cloth diapers, bibs, pillow-like toys, wedges, infant positioners, special mattresses, special sleep surfaces, and other similar items.

## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Based on the investigation, Section for Child Care Regulations determined that Westport Montessori, LLC violated the licensing rules above.

On December 14, 2020, the reporter stated that infants were sleeping with pacifier lanyard attached to clothing and crib. On December 15, 2020, CCFS Madeline Dumercy conducted an unannounced inspection at Westport Montessori, LLC and interviewed Director Christina Wright and Caregivers Kavanna Sharp and Jamie Tolliver. During the interviews, Caregiver Jamie Tolliver stated that infants were sleeping in the crib with the pacifier attached to a lanyard to their clothing. Director Christina Wright had the infant teachers sign a statement understanding the concerns on lifting children and items being left in cribs. On December 15, 2020, CCFS Madeline Dumercy observed the statement that Caregivers Kavanna and Jamie signed on December 11, 2020.

Based on interviews, there is sufficient evidence that the complaint is substantiated.
