Caregivers shall not leave any child without competent adult supervision.

19 CSR 30-62.182 (1)(A)(3)

Caregivers shall provide frequent, direct contact so children are not left unobserved on the premises.

19 CSR 30-62.182 (1)(A)(4)

Children under three (3) shall be supervised and assisted while in the bathroom.

19 CSR 30-62.182 (1)(A)(5)

A caregiver shall remain in the room with preschool and school-age children while they are napping or sleeping and shall be able to see and hear them if they have difficulty during napping or when they awaken.

19 CSR 30-62.192 (5)(A)

In case of accident or injury to a child, the provider shall notify the parent(s) immediately. If the child requires emergency medical care, the provider shall follow the parent(s) written instructions.

CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Section for Child Care Regulation Rising Sun Learning Center has violated licensing rules in that children were left unsupervised in the childcare facility on various occasions based on information obtained from interviews and observation.

On Friday, July 26, 2019, CCFS Ferro made an unannounced inspection of the facility and observed a preschool age child lying on a cot in the office, with no lights on and no caregiver in the room. CCFS Ferro interviewed assistant director Jessica Tran and caregivers Chelsee Thornton and Savannah Tiffany. Former caregiver, Shaholly Butler, was also interviewed offsite.

Assistant director, Jessica Tran stated that the preschool boy in the office has trouble napping in his room and so is allowed to nap in the office. Caregiver, Savannah Tiffany, also observed the boy alone in the office and confirmed that this occurs regularly.

All caregivers interviewed, Jessica Tran, Chelsee Thornton, Savannah Tiffany, and former caregiver Shaholly Butler, all stated that other children have been left unsupervised, without caregiver's knowledge, on prior occasions within the past couple weeks.

On Friday, July 19, 2019, caregivers Shaholly Butler and Chelsee Thornton, took the children from their room outside to the playground and left Child A, a two (2) year old female, in the bathroom for two (2) to five (5) minutes. Child A was discovered alone in the bathroom by Savannah Tiffany.

On Tuesday, July 23, 2019, caregivers Shaholly Butler and Chelsee Thornton were bringing the children from their room inside from the playground and left a two (2) year old male, Child B, on the playground. Child B was also discovered by Savannah Tiffany. Child B was left unsupervised for approximately two (2) to five (5) minutes.

CORRECTIVE MEASURES

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Director Megan Huffman will conduct a staff meeting to discuss the three incidents of staff leaving children without supervision, reviewing the supervision requirements of licensing rules. All facility staff will sign a statement of
