## **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

### VIOLATION(S)

RSMo 210.211.1

It shall be unlawful for any person to establish, maintain or operate a child-care facility for children, or to advertise or hold himself or herself out as being able to perform any of the services as defined in section 210.201, without having in effect a written license granted by the department of elementary and secondary education.

### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Compliance Inspector (CI) Stephanie Spaulding investigated an allegation that the provider is watching more than six children without a license. Based on observation and information provided from Kidco MO Ltd, this allegation is found to be substantiated and the following statue is being cited.

RSMo 210.211.1 - It shall be unlawful for any person to establish, maintain or operate a child-care facility for children, or to advertise or hold himself or herself out as being able to perform any of the services as defined in section 210.201, without having in effect a written license granted by the department of health and senior services.

On May 20, 2022, CI Spaulding determined that Kidco MO Ltd does not have an active and approved license to operate a child care program. At the time of inspection, there were 56 children present to include seven children under 2-years-old in care.

On May 20, 2022, director, Hannah Suits stated that the facility recently did a change of ownership, that the new owners are in the process of obtaining a license, and that the facility is currently operating.
