# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

# VIOLATION(S)

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)3.

Only constructive, age-appropriate methods of discipline shall be used to help children develop self-control and assume responsibility for their own actions.

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)7.

Physical punishment including, but not limited to, spanking, slapping, shaking, biting, or pulling hair shall be prohibited.

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)8.

No discipline technique which is humiliating, threatening, or frightening to children shall be used. Children shall not be shamed, ridiculed, or spoken to harshly, abusively, or with profanity.

### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

On December 9, 2022, the Office of the Childhood received an allegation that a staff at the facility had yanked a child by her arms. After conducting an investigation, Compliance Inspector (CI) Caylin Mertz has found this allegation to be substantiated based on the following evidence and rule violations:

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)3 Only constructive, age-appropriate methods of discipline shall be used to help children develop self-control and assume responsibility for their own actions.

AND

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)7 Physical punishment including, but not limited to, spanking, slapping, shaking, biting, or pulling hair shall be prohibited.

**AND** 

5 CSR 25-500.182(1)(C)8 No discipline technique which is humiliating, threatening, or frightening to children shall be used. Children shall not be shamed, ridiculed, or spoken to harshly, abusively, or with profanity.

On December 12, 2022 Compliance Inspector (CI) Caylin Mertz and CI Heather Radney conducted an unannounced inspection at the facility. The video footage of the alleged incident was received and reviewed. The video clearly shows staff B.G. grab Child A (two-years-old) by her wrists and lift her from the floor in an attempt to redirect to her to wash her hands. Physical punishment such as grabbing a child and lifting them from the floor by their wrists is prohibited and is not a constructive or age-appropriate way to direct any child. Child B's father was interviewed, he witnessed the incident and stated the child screamed and cried after being grabbed. Child B's father went on to state that Child A (two-years-old) looked over at him after being grabbed and appeared upset. B.G.'s employment was terminated at the facility due to this incident.

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The facility shall conduct a staff meeting to review the policies and all licensing rules and regulations regarding discipline, specifically "only constructive, age-appropriate methods of discipline shall be used to help children develop
