CONCLUSION SUMMARY

On August 26, 2020, Child Care Facility Specialist (CCFS) Jessica Graham investigated the allegation that on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, Mike Massey with the Division of Fire Safety made an inspection to examine a carbon monoxide detector at the facility. When Mike removed the detector from the ceiling in the kitchen, roaches went crawling everywhere. This allegation is substantiated based on the following rule violation:

19 CSR 30-62.082 which states: "The facility shall be clean at all times and free of dirt, insects, spiders, rodents or other pests."

On August 26, 2020, caregivers Pam Murphy and Alyssa Murphy stated that they have seen roaches crawling on the floors at the facility. Alyssa stated that when she enters the facility at 5:30am and turns on the lights, the roaches are crawling on the tables and floors.

CCFS observed a dead roach by the carbon monoxide detector in the kitchen and saw antenna of other bugs behind the outlet plate in the kitchen.
