# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

# VIOLATION(S)

19 CSR 30-62.192 (3)(B)

All medication shall be given to a child only with the dated, written permission of the parent(s) stating the length of time medication may be given.

19 CSR 30-62.192 (3)(D)

All nonprescription medication shall be in the original container and labeled by the parent(s) with the child's name, and instructions for administration, including the times and amounts for dosages.

19 CSR 30-62.192 (3)(I)

The date and time(s) of administration, the name of the individual giving the medication and the quantity of any medication given shall be recorded promptly after administration. This information shall be filed in the child's record after the medication is no longer necessary.

## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

The SCCR has determined that Wild Blooms was in violation of regulations. This determination is being based upon statements made by Child A's teacher, Tiffany Pierson, indicating that she applied Neosporin to the bite on the child's arm, but did not have a Medication Authorization or other written statement singed by his parent indicating the length of time medication may be given. Tiffany Pierson stated that she did not record the name of the caregiver applying Neosporin to Child A, the amount applied, and did not file this information in the child's record. Child Care Facility Specialist, Jim Parsley, examined Child A's record during the inspection on March 10, 2021, and could not locate authorization or written permission from the child's parent authorizing or documenting application of Neosporin to the child. Finally, two accident reports, one dated October 20, 2020 and the other dated January 15, 2021, respectively indicate that antibiotic cream was applied to the bite on Child A's arm on both occasions.
