**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

The allegation that Child A (15-months-old) has food allergies to cheese and milk and on an unknown date, the daycare fed Child A mac and cheese and that then Child A had an upset stomach , is substantiated. The following rule was violated:

19 CSR 30-62.202 (2)(B): The written diet plan for each infant/toddler shall be followed. The parent(s) shall update the plan according to the individual needs of the child until they grant permission in writing for the child to eat table foods.

On July 13, 2021, Compliance Inspector (CI) Marla Chrisco conducted an investigation and interviewed the facility director Kim Healey and caregivers Hannah Nolting and Niki Chiodini. All of whom stated that Parent A verbally told them that Parent A preferred to have Child A drink almond milk instead of whole milk but never stated that Child A could not have Mac and Cheese or put in writing what foods and drinks Child A could and could not have .

CI Chrisco also observed Child A's Infant and Toddler Feeding Care Plan which was not completed by Parent A stating what table foods and drinks Child A could and could not have.

**CORRECTIVE MEASURES**

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The facility shall conduct a staff meeting to review licensing rule 19 CSR 30-62.202 (2)(B) and all licensing rules regarding Nutrition and Food Service. The facility must provide the Office of Childhood with a statement, signed by all staff (paid employees or unpaid volunteers), to indicate they understand and agree to follow the rules and regulations.
