## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Based on the observation of CCFS Riley during the inspection at the facility on April 2, 2019 and an interview with center Director Linda Rosenblatt, the allegation that there are incorrect staff to child ratios is substantiated. The facility is in violation of the following licensing rule:

19 CSR 30-62.112 (1)(A)Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2)- years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group.

CCFS Riley observed 5 infants between the ages of 3 months-10 years with one caregiver.

Linda Rosenblatt stated that all the kids came in early on the date of CCFS Riley's inspection and that the facility was not out ratio, but that the other teacher was just coming in and that she herself was on site, but in the kitchen. She further stated that CCFS Riley couldn't say that every center is in ratio all the time.
