CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The allegation that caregiver Casey Thompson pats the back of Child A, a 13 month-old, too hard at naptime, is being substantiated.

On February 11, 2021, CCFS Marla Chrisco conducted an interview with caregiver Camryn Green who stated that on February 09, 2021, she was working in the classroom with caregiver Casey Thompson during naptime. Ms. Casey was patting Child A too hard on the back and Child A was screaming and crying. Ms. Camryn was concerned so recorded the incident and reported it to director Linda Huning. Child A did not have any marks or bruises on Child A's back.

On February 11, 2021, Child Facility Specialist (CCFS) Marla Chrisco observed video footage recorded by caregiver Camryn Green on February 09, 2021. In the video footage, there is music playing loudly and a loud patting noise and a child crying. There is no video footage showing any caregivers or any children. Ms. Camryn was in the room taking the video footage and informed CCFS Chrisco that the loud patting was from caregiver Casey Thompson patting Child A on the back and the screaming and crying was from Child A.

The reporter was unknown and therefore could not be interviewed.
