## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Office of Childhood, Child Care Compliance has determined that Community Child Development Center, Inc. was in violation of the above licensing rule on October 5, 2021, based on statements from staff at Community Child Development Center, Inc. Kachette Holmes, infant teacher, Tonya Ryherd, assistant director, and Diane Barton, staff, all stated that Child A's parents were not immediately contacted after Child A's incident. This decision is also based on Compliance Inspector (CI) Susan Douglas' observation of the incident report for Child A dated July 30, 2021, that stated Child A's parents were not contacted at the time of incident.
