CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Based on the information obtained during interviews with Annette Weber, caregivers Tasha Weaver and Becky Akes and former caregiver Pam Engleman, CCFS Hohensee determined these rule violations are substantiated. Pam Engleman admitted to shoving Child A in the classroom. Caregiver, Tasha Weaver reported she heard Pam Engleman use hurtful or shaming speech towards a child as well as saw the physical punishment of shoving. Becky Akes reported she did see Pam Engleman shove Child A.
