**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Based on evidence obtained from interviews and observation, SCCR has determined that the allegation that a child was in unapproved space is substantiated.

CCFS Ferro conducted interviews with the Parent of A&B and Child B by phone on 7/13/20. Parent A&B declined to have Child A interviewed as she did not think Child A would be comfortable being interviewed. Child B stated the children were asked to go in a back bedroom and work on an art project. They got glue out and got glue on the carpet and the provider came in and told them to get out.

CCFS Ferro interviewed provider, Amelia Rosin, during an unannounced inspection at her family child care home on 7/16/20. Amelia denied that children are ever allowed to either do art projects upstairs or allowed to go to any of the bedrooms down the hall that is separated from approved space by a baby gate. However, Amelia stated that Child A, who is 10 years old and able to open a baby gate, would go past the baby gate into one of her children's bedroom and refuse to leave when requested to. Amelia provided CCFS Ferro a photo of Child A in a bedroom which she had sent to Parent A&B reporting the child's behavior and refusal to stay in the designated area.

Based on these statements, this allegation is substantiated.
