### **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

#### VIOLATION(S)

#### 5 CSR 25-500.092(1)(C)2.

Infants and toddlers. Infants and toddlers who are unable to sit at a table shall have one (1) piece of mealtime feeding equipment for every four (4) infant/toddlers which may include feeding tables, high chairs, infant seats or other safely designed infant seating equipment. Equipment shall be provided which will allow the child to sit comfortably and securely while being fed. Appropriate restraints shall be used.

#### 5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(A)

Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2) years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group;

#### 5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(C)

Ages Three Through Four (3-4) Years. Groups composed solely of three (3) - and four (4) -year olds shall haveno less than one (1) adult to ten (10) children:

#### 5 CSR 25-500.112(2)

If a center has an attendance of more than fifty (50) children, the center director or individual in charge shall not be included in staff/child ratios except during naptime or on an emergency substitute basis.

#### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

On December 14, 2022, the Office of Childhood received an allegation that the facility is out of ratio and children are not strapped into sitting equipment. After conducting an investigation, Compliance Inspector (CI) JD Greer has found the allegation to be substantiated based on the following evidence:

5 CSR 25-500.092(1)(C)2. which states, "Infants and toddlers. Infants and toddlers who are unable to sit at a table shall have one (1) piece of mealtime feeding equipment for every four (4) infant/toddlers which may include feeding tables, high chairs, infant seats or other safely designed infant seating equipment. Equipment shall be provided which will allow the child to sit comfortably and securely while being fed. Appropriate restraints shall be used."

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer conducted a walkthrough of the building and observed seven of the infant/toddlers sitting in seats were unbuckled. CI Greer observed each seat had a buckle that was not in use.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Taylor Tuttle who stated she knows straps on chairs need to be used with toddlers, but she got nervous and didn't buckle them.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Mikayla Howard who stated the caregivers in the toddler room often do not buckle children into the seats.

5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(A) which states, "Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2) years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group;"

AND

5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(C) which states, "Ages Three Through Four (3-4) Years. Groups composed solely of three (3) - and four (4)

-year olds shall have no less than one (1) adult to ten (10) children;"

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Bethany Danahy who stated the facility does not have enough staff and it is a daily issue. There are twelve children in the toddler room at least a few times a week.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Ellaina Blackmon who stated the facility is out of ratio once or twice a week. The Pre-K and 3's rooms tend to be the two rooms that are often out of ratio.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Taylor Tuttle who stated in the past two weeks, the facility was out of ratio on Monday and Wednesday. She believes it was approximately 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. that the facility was out of ratio. The 2's classroom was out of ratio a couple months ago. The ratio in the 2's room was 1:10 or 1:11 for a few hours.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Kassidy Beal who stated the toddler classroom is out of ratio almost every day. Two or three toddlers are often placed in the 2-year-old room almost every day. Pre-k is only out of ratio when school-age children are at the facility. Morning time tends to be when ratios are the worst. The 3-year-old room has ratio issues every morning. The 3-year-old room is often 3-4 children over ratio.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Erica Brown who stated she has seen up to 12 children in the toddler room, but usually just 10. The 3's room is often out of ratio. The evening of December 20, 2022, the Pre-K classroom was out of ratio with 1:15.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Natalie Pearson who stated the 3-year-old room was out of ratio a couple weeks ago.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer interviewed Caregiver Mikayla Howard who stated the toddler room has ratio issues every day. Toddlers will be moved to the infant room or up to 2's room.

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer conducted a walkthrough of the facility and observed Caregivers Courtney Brothers, Taylor Tuttle, and Jamie Savage were present with twelve infants/toddlers, 10-months-old to 15-months-old. Caregiver Kassidy Beal was present with nine children, seven 2-years-old, one 16-months-old, and one 17-months-old. The room is not part of the infant/toddler unit.

5 CSR 25-500.112(2) which states, "If a center has an attendance of more than fifty (50) children, the center director or individual in charge shall not be included in staff/child ratios except during naptime or on an emergency substitute basis."

On December 21, 2022, CI Greer conducted a walkthrough of the building and observed Director Hunter Johnston was present with three school age children. The center had an attendance of 68 children.

children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group;" AND 5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(C) which states, "Ages Three Through Four (3-4) Years. Groups
