The Office Of Childhood determined that the allegation of this complaint was substantiated . The determination is based on the interview of Nicole Kincaid (director) and Jasmine Smith (teacher).

Kincaid stated the following:

- May 31, 2021 was Child A's first day at the facility.
- Child A was fed at 5AM at home by his parents.
- Child A was fed at 10AM by the teachers.
- Child A fell asleep after the 10AM feeding and slept until 3PM.
- Kaylee was making a bottle for Child A when his father arrived to pick him up .
- Child A's father said not to make the bottle.

Smith stated the following:

- She said she was working in the WEE One's Room that day.
- She said that Child A arrived and took a short nap .
- She said that Child A then slept until about 10AM.
- She said Child A took a few ounces from his bottle and then went back to sleep .
- She said Child A had been rejecting the bottle before going to sleep .

CI Gregg Gillen observed the Feeding Plan for Child A. It indicated that Child a should be fed formula every 3-5 hours and baby food every 3-5 hours.
