CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Compliance Inspector (CI) Laura Wilmesher conducted an investigation regarding the allegation that the playground equipment is tearing off by the black pad. The allegation is substantiated based on the following information:

5 CSR 25-300.090 (4)(G) which states: "Outdoor equipment shall be safely constructed, in good condition, and free of sharp, loose or pointed parts. Stationary equipment such as swings, slides and climbers shall be anchored securely;"

On October 6, 2021, CI Wilmesher conducted a walkthrough of the facility's outdoor space and observed several areas of the large playground equipment in which the black padding had detached and was pulling away from the metal. This caused rusted metal to be exposed.

On October 6, 2021, director Jasmine Potter stated that she didn't know the black padding was peeling. The year prior, the black padding part of the playground equipment had to be repaired, but no one had informed her that it was peeling again.
