# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

## VIOLATION(S)

19 CSR 30-62.132 (5)

If infant/toddler care is provided in a unit auxiliary to a licensed facility for older children, the following shall apply.

19 CSR 30-62.132 (5)(B)

The infant/toddler unit shall not care for children older than two (2) years unless the total number of children in attendance at the time is four (4) or fewer.

19 CSR 30-62.082 (2)(B)(2)(B)(III)

If a unit for infants and toddlers is auxiliary to a facility for older children, centers initially licensed for infant/toddler care after the effective date of these rules or facilities adding new infant/toddler space, shall have play, sleeping and bathroom space in the infant and toddler unit. This space shall be separated from the space used for older children by floor-to-ceiling walls.

## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

SCCR has determined that End of the Rainbow CDC was in violation of the above rules on August 23, 2019 based on statements from:

- -Director Shane Wyatt that there was a school age boy (Child A) in the toddler 2 room, he would not be in the room often and that Child A's mother teaches the toddler 2 classroom, and he would visit her.
- -Namita Sateatha that there is only one school age boy that she has ever seen in the infant/toddler classroom and that is Child A because his mother is a teacher in the classroom, she has only seen Child A in the classroom twice, and she has seen Child A eat breakfast and lunch in the classroom.
- -Nikki Reynolds that there was a school age boy (Child A) that would be in the toddler two classroom every now and then and that she did not know that the school age boy was not allowed in the classroom.
- -Jessica Patterson that there has been a school age child (Child A) in the classroom every once in a while, Parent of Child A is a teacher at the facility and Child A stays in her classroom, and that Child A comes into the classroom in the afternoon for about an hour and a half or 30 to 40 minutes in the morning time.
- Parent of Child A, who is also a facility staff member, that Child A did come to visit her in her class during the summer, his time in the classroom varied, he would come in two or three times a week around 3:40 pm because she would normally get off of work at 4:45 or 5:15pm, he would stay for about an hour and a half, and that he would come and eat lunch sometimes.
