#### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

The Office of Childhood - Child Care Compliance has determined that this allegation is substantiated based on interviews with Director, Terri Blanchford and caregivers Sara Woods-Hodges, Paula Ray, Darlin Saavedra, Kayla Fonville and observations made by CI Crystal Heiser.

Terri Blanchford owner/director stated when Child A was getting left longer and longer, she had a discussion with parent that Child A did not know how to interact with the other children and that they were not functioning well in this environment. Regarding Child A's behavior towards others Terri explained to the parent that Child A would poke children in the eyes or claw at their face, which was likely due to them being practically non communicative. Terri discussed with the parent how difficult it was to change Child A's diapers as Child A would fight them when they attempted and that Child A would not use the restroom on their own while at school. When CI Heiser inquired about seeing records of Child A's behavior Terri stated that she did not have incident reports regarding behavior or injuries for Child A.

Sara Woods-Hodges, caregiver, stated that Child A was difficult to handle behavior wise. According to Sara Child A would go after the other children pulling hair, pinching their faces or they would push them. Sara stated that is seemed for no reason and that there was no trigger warnings so that teachers could stop it from happening. Sara told CI Heiser that she was unsure if accident or injury forms were completed.

Caregivers Paul Ray and Kayla Fonville had recently started working at Montessori Day School of Blue Springs and could give no information pertaining to Child A. Darlin Saavedra works only in the nursery room and could no information regarding Child A.
