19 CSR 30-62.182 (1)(D)(1)

Infants and toddlers shall have constant care and supervision. Home monitors or commercial devices marketed to reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) shall not be used in place of supervision while children are napping or sleeping.

19 CSR 30-62.192 (5)(A)

In case of accident or injury to a child, the provider shall notify the parent(s) immediately. If the child requires emergency medical care, the provider shall follow the parent(s) written instructions.

19 CSR 30-62.192 (5)(B)

Information regarding the date and circumstance of any accident or injury shall be noted in the child's record.

19 CSR 30-62.082 (4)(A)

A safe diapering table with a waterproof washable surface shall be used for changing diapers . The diapering table shall be located within or adjacent to the group space so the caregiver using the diapering table can maintain supervision of his/her group of children at all times.

**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

This allegation is based on the following rule violations:

19 CSR 30-62.182 (1)(D)(1) Infants and toddlers shall have constant care and supervision. Home monitors or commercial devices marketed to reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) shall not be used in place of supervision while children are napping or sleeping.

19 CSR 30-62.082 (4)(A) A safe diapering table with a waterproof washable surface shall be used for changing diapers . The diapering table shall be located within or adjacent to the group space so the caregiver using the diapering table can maintain supervision of his/her group of children at all times.

On February 13, 2019, Ronna Chilton, caregiver/managing member stated she was changing a child's diaper using a changing table located in the bathroom. The bathroom is located in the infant/toddler unit in an area of the classroom where other children in the room cannot be supervised. During the interview Ronna Chilton stated she was told before by both Child Care Supervisor Missy Smith and Child Care Facility Specialist Jessica Graham she should not be diapering at that table because of supervision issues. While changing a diaper, Child A (17 months) walked out of the infant/toddler unit door and was outside alone for approximately one minute. Child A was found by a neighbor driving by, standing outside of the facility. The director also saw Child A about the same time as the neighbor and went outside and got him to bring him back inside .

Further, during the investigation, Ronna Childers also stated that Child A "messes with door all the time, but this is the first time he actually got it open."

Don Abner, a neighbor, confirmed that on February 13, 2019 he was leaving his house a couple of doors down from the daycare. He saw Child A standing on the sidewalk with no adult present so he stopped and started walking toward Child A . He said within 10-15 seconds a staff person walked out and got Child A.

Emily Kennan stated that on February 13, 2019 she saw Don Abner, a daycare neighbor stopped in the road outside the

daycare and wondered what he was doing. She went outside and saw Child A standing next to the sidewalk and took him back in and let Ronna know he was outside. Emily thought he was only outside for a minute.

Ronna Chilton stated that the incident occurred at approximately 10:00am on February 13, 2019; however, she stated she told the Father of Child A when he arrived at pick up which was sometime that afternoon. While the Father of Child A could not be reached for an interview, the Mother of Child A stated she was not aware that Child A had gotten out of the building at all. When the Father of Child A picked Child A up that day, Ronna had him sign a paper about a biting incident and casually mentioned to the Father of Child A that Child A kept messing with the door so they now had to lock it. Ronna told the Father of Child A that he had opened the door and had one foot outside before she got him back in.

Emily Kennan stated that she heard Ronna talking about the incident with the Father of Child A when he arrived that afternoon for pick up.

There was no documentation in the file about the incident that had occurred.
