# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

## VIOLATION(S)

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(A)

In case of accident or injury to a child, the provider shall notify the parent(s) immediately. If the child requires emergency medical care, the provider shall follow the parent's(s') written instructions.

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(B)

Information regarding the date and circumstance of any accident or injury shall be noted in the child's record.

## **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

On June 7, 2022, Compliance Inspector Jessica Graham investigated the allegation that On June 1, 2022, Child A, (DOB: 9/29/21) had a scratch on his nose. Lexie, staff, did not know how the scratch happened. She did not receive a phone call letting her know about the scratch. This allegation is substantiated based on the following rule violations.

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(A) which states: "In case of accident or injury to a child, the provider shall notify the parent(s) immediately. If the child requires emergency medical care, the provider shall follow the parent's(s') written instructions." AND

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(B) which states: "Information regarding the date and circumstance of any accident or injury shall be noted in the child's record."

On June 7, 2022, caregiver Alexis "Lexie" West stated that she noticed a scratch on Child A's nose around 3:00pm on June 1, 2022, when she was changing his diaper. Ms. Lexie was not sure how he got the scratch. She said the scratch was not bleeding but did look fresh. Ms. Lexie told Parent A about the scratch at 4:30pm when she picked up Child A. She did not document the scratch on a report since she didn't know what happened.

On June 8, 2022, Parent A stated that she noticed an "abrasion" on Child A's nose when she picked him up on June 1, 2022. Ms. Lexie told her she was not aware of what happened to Child A. Parent A did not receive any notification of the injury prior to picking up Child A that afternoon or receive a written report.
