CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Office of Childhood determined the facility did violate the above Licensed-Exempt rule. This determination is based on the interviews with Director Melinda Polm on November 15, 2021, and November 17, 2021, and direct observation of Compliance Inspector (CI) Elaine Cox on November 15, 2021. While there is mold in the south walls in the Greene, Yellow, Blue, Violet and Purple rooms, the facility took immediate steps to protect the children from the affects of mold exposure by moving the classrooms into unaffected approved areas of the building. The facility immediately contacted a contractor to remove the mold affected dry wall, insulation, cove base and flooring in these rooms. Further the facility, when discovered the water was entering the building from the play yard, they arranged for the play yard to be regraded away from the building to prevent this from occurring again.

CORRECTIVE MEASURES

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All mold in the facility shall be remediated. The facility will continue to make the effected rooms inaccessible to the children until the the facility receives an approved sanitation inspection. The facility shall submit a copy of the sanitation inspection to the Office of Childhood.
