5 CSR 25-400.185 (4)(A)

No child shall be permitted to enroll in or attend any day care facility caring for ten (10) or more children unless the child has been adequately immunized against vaccine-preventable childhood illnesses specified by the department in accordance with recommendations of the Immunization Practices Advisory Committee (ACIP). The parent or guardian of the child shall provide satisfactory evidence of the required immunizations. Satisfactory evidence means a statement, certificate or record from a physician or other recognized health facility or personnel, stating that the required immunizations have been given to the child and verifying the type of vaccine and the month, day and year of administration.

CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Compliance Inspector (CI) Laura Wilmesher conducted an investigation regarding the allegation that provider, Nadera, does not require shot records for the children in her care. After conducting the investigation, CI Wilmesher finds this allegation is substantiated. This conclusion is based on the following evidence of licensing rule violations which occurred at the facility:

On October 25, 2021, CI Wilmesher conducted an unannounced inspection of the facility. During the inspection, CI Wilmesher observed all of the children's files and observed that Child A did not have an immunization record at the time of inspection.

On October 25, 2021, CI Wilmesher interviewed provider Nadera Abounader who stated she does require the parents to bring an immunization record before a child can attend her child care, but that Parent A must have forgotten to bring Child A's immunization record.

CORRECTIVE MEASURES

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The provider and assistants shall review the provider's policies and all licensing rules and regulations regarding 5 CSR 25-400.185 (4) Immunizations. The facility must provide the Office of Childhood with a statement, signed by all staff members (paid employees and paid/unpaid volunteers), to indicate they understand and agree to follow those rules and regulations.
