CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Office of Childhood determined the allegations of this complaint to be substantiated. The determination is based on documentation reviewed through the course of the investigation, observations made by Compliance Inspector (CI) Michelle Trussell and interviews conducted with the director, Megan Murray; caregiver, Brooklyn McGaughy and Parent A.

CI Trussell conducted an investigation regarding the allegation that on January 27, 2022, caregiver Lana Poland grabbed Child A by the arms and physically held him down on the floor.

On January 31, 2022 CI Trussell conducted interviews with Megan Murray and Brooklyn McGaughy. Child A was not present at the time of the investigation but Ms. Murray indicated he still attends the facility. An phone interview was conducted by CI Trussell on April 1, 2022 with Parent A.

After conducting the investigation, it was determined through interviews with caregivers and Parent A, Child A, 21-months old, was not provided age-appropriate discipline while in care at the facility on January 27, 2022 from Lana Poland. Furthermore, it was determined through interviews on January 27, 2022 Ms. Poland grabbed Child A's arms and physically held him down on the floor while using harsh tones when speaking to Child A. .

ridiculed, or spoken to harshly, abusively, or with profanity.

According to information obtained in interviews and documentation reviewed, on January 27, 2022 Ms. Poland grabbed Child A by the arms and pushed him onto the floor. Ms. Poland continued to hold onto Child A's arms while he was on the floor and yelled at him to calm down and "We don't do that".
