# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

#### VIOLATION(S)

5 CSR 25-500.112(1)

The following staff/child ratios shall be maintained on the premises at all times:

#### 5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(A)

Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2) years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group;

## 5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(C)

Ages Three Through Four (3-4) Years. Groups composed solely of three (3) - and four (4) -year olds shall haveno less than one (1) adult to ten (10) children;

#### CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Office of Childhood determined the allegations of this compliant to be substantiated. This determination is based on observations made by CI Trussell and an interview conducted with director, Lauren Osborn.

On January 18, 2022 CI Trussell observed staff/child ratios to be out of compliance in both the Wee Ones classroom and Super Stars classroom. The Wee Ones classroom had one caregiver with five children, ages 3-months to 6-months old. The Super Stars classroom had one caregiver with seventeen children, thirteen 3-year old children and four 4-year old children.

Furthermore, Lauren Osborn stated due to caregivers calling out of work that morning and not having additional staff was the reason for the facility to be out of staff/child ratios.

#### VIOLATION(S)

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)

Accidents, Injuries and Emergency Medical Care.

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(A)

In case of accident or injury to a child, the provider shall notify the parent(s) immediately. If the child requires emergency medical care, the provider shall follow the parent's(s') written instructions.

5 CSR 25-500.192(5)(B)

Information regarding the date and circumstance of any accident or injury shall be noted in the child's record.

### CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Office of Childhood determined the allegation to be substantiated. The determination is based on observations made by CI Trussell and interviews conducted with caregivers, Vanessa Maxwell and Ashley Nelson.

Vanessa Maxwell stated Child A was sitting on Child B's lap. Ms. Maxwell stated Child A fell off of Child B's lap and hit his head on the floor. Ms. Maxwell stated the facility did not contact the parent because the incident occurred at the end of the day and Parent A was picking Child A and Child B up soon. Ms. Maxwell stated an incident report was completed and Parent A signed the report. CI Trussell asked to review the report. Ms. Maxwell could not locate the report in the file.

Ashley Nelson stated Child A was sitting on Child B's lap. Ms. Nelson stated Child B leaned forward causing Child A to fall backwards and hit his head on the floor. Ms. Nelson stated she completed an Accident/Injury Report at the time of the incident.

Ms. Nelson stated she spoke to Parent A about the incident at the time of pick up. Parent A signed the report. Ms. Nelson stated she left the report on the counter in the Super Stars room and did not see the report after that day. Ms. Nelson stated she was not aware parents were to be contacted immediately at the time of an accident.

The Office of Childhood requested a copy of the signed Accident/Injury Report from the facility on two separate occasions and never received a copy of the report.
