**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

SCCR has determined the above allegations were substantiated based on Misty Addison's own admission to having fallen asleep while caring for Child B in January of 2017. Parent of Child B also stated that she had to wake up caregiver Misty Addison when she arrived at the facility to pick up her child.

Caregivers shall not leave any child without competent adult supervision.

Caregivers shall provide frequent, direct contact so children are not left unobserved on the premises.

Infants and toddlers shall have constant care and supervision. Home monitors or commercial devices marketed to reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) shall not be used in place of supervision while children are napping or sleeping.

Information regarding the date and circumstance of any accident or injury shall be noted in the child's record.

**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

SCCR has determined the above allegation is substantiated based off the information that Parent of Child A and caregiver Carrie Ledbetter both stated that Child A was observed outside alone for a few minutes. Caregiver Misty Addison also stated that Child A got out of the infant/toddler classroom when she was in the restroom. No incident report was placed in Child A's file or given to the parent regarding what happen at the facility on this day or days following.
