CONCLUSION SUMMARY

The Section for Child Care regulations has determined that Young Minds Learning Academy did violate licensing rules, and the complaint is substantiated. This substantiated conclusion was based on statements provided by the Director Devin Libby and Caregiver, Marissa Russell. The Director, Devin Libby stated that Round Up was used on the school age playground, the afternoon of Friday September 20, 2019. Devin Libby also stated that she must have been distracted and left the Round Up can on the playground, due to a parent or child needing her attention. Devin Libby stated that no children have been using the school age playground due to weeds and ticks. Caregiver, Marissa Russell stated that she did see Round Up on Monday September 20, 2019, but it was outside of the infant fence in the parking lot.
