**CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Section for Child Care Regulation has determined that Creative World School, Inc. violated these licensing rules based on interviewees conducted by CCFS Jill Zeigenbein with Caregivers Ronni Sparks, Andrea Andrus, Kaylee Cassidy, Alexandra Naylor, Brooke Beasley, Cecily Johnson and Child A's mom. During these interviews all interviewed were consistent that Child A was in pain and couldn't lift his left arm. According to the Accident Report Child A's pain started at 2:15 p.m. and according to Child A's mom, she was not informed that Child A was injured until 3:30 pm.

Also during the investigation, it was determined that additional rules were violated based on interviews with Alexandra Naylor and Kaylee Cassidy that Child A was given Tylenol by verbal consent from Child A's mom. Further it was determined that the Tylenol is kept at the daycare and not returned to parents or disposed of when no longer being administered and according to the Medication Authorization Form in Child A's file, the Tylenol is given PRN.
