# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

## VIOLATION(S)

19 CSR 30-62.082 (1)(C)

Children shall have no access to areas not approved for child care.

19 CSR 30-62.112 (1)(A)

Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2)- years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group.

#### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Based on interviews with the staff and review of the child attendance records, Child Care Facility Specialist (CCFS) Brooke Poskin was able to determine that on November 13, 2017, the facility violated the staff/child ratio regulations when one staff person cared for more than 4 children - up to 9 children - including at least one child under 24 months of age. CCFS Poskin was also able to determine that on November 13, 2017, the facility cared for children under 24 months in classrooms that were not approved for the care of children under 24 months. The director JoAnn Lazier informed CCFS Poskin by email on November 13, 2017 that this had occurred due to an opening staff person not showing up for work that morning. This staff person's absence resulted in insufficient staff to take care of the children and meet ratio early in the morning and for children under 24 months being cared for in the preschool classroom.
