CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Compliance Inspector (CI) Jessica Glover conducted an investigation regarding the allegation that staff/child ratios were not maintained in the infant/toddler classroom and that the facility was short-staffed. After conducting the investigation, CI Glover finds this allegation is substantiated. This conclusion is based on the following evidence of licensing rule violations which occurred at the facility:

5 CSR 25-500.112(1)(A) which states: "Birth Through Two (2) Years. Groups composed of mixed ages through two (2) years shall have no less than one (1) adult to four (4) children, with no more than eight (8) children in a group;"

On March 31, 2022, CI Glover conducted a walkthrough of the facility and observed a violation of staff/child ratios. Specifically, Caregiver Kennedy Wilson was caring for six children, ages 6-months-old to 23-months-old.

On April 14, 2022, Director Deborah Clark stated that there were issues with maintaining staff/child ratios in the past when multiple teachers would call in on the same day but it was no longer a concern at the facility.
