# **RULE/STATUTE VIOLATION(S)**

#### VIOLATION(S)

5 CSR 25-500.082(2)(A)2.

Open windows and doors shall be screened securely. Barriers to prevent children from falling against windows or falling from windows shall be provided when windows are less than twenty-four inches (24") from the floor and not constructed of safety glass or other nonbreakable material.

#### **CONCLUSION SUMMARY**

Compliance Inspector (CI) Jessica Glover and Compliance Inspection Supervisor (CIS) Crystal Heiser conducted an unannounced investigation of the allegation that Ms. Victoria has opened her classroom window without a screen. The allegation is substantiated based on the following evidence:

On December 14, 2021, Director Rayna Young stated there is no screen on the window of Ms. Victoria's classroom. She told Ms. Victoria is was okay to open the window even though there was no screen.

On December 14, 2021, caregiver Victoria Blakeman stated she has opened the window without a screen in the classroom. She does this to create a breeze in the room.
