CONCLUSION SUMMARY

Based on interviews and observation Section for Child Care Regulation (SCCR) has determined this allegation to be substantiated.

On July 12, 2021 Child Care Facility Specialist (CCFS) Penny Snodgrass conducted an unannounced inspection at the facility arriving at 3:30 PM. During the inspection interviews were conducted with staff members Nakesha Jackson, Cicely Ruff, Candace Ruff and Kaenisha Kennedy.

Staff member Nakesha Jackson stated she has seen both dead and alive spiders at the facility. Candace Ruff who is one of the supervisors stated that she doesn't have any major concerns but she has seen roly polys, some hopping bugs and beetles towards the doors in the building and the bugs have been both alive and dead. During a telephone interview with staff member Kaenisha Kennedy she stated that she has seen beetles by the classroom doors.

During the inspection CCFS Snodgrass observed the following:

*In the first classroom to the left once you enter the facility CCFS Snodgrass observed dead spiders, dead ants and mouse droppings on the floor in the corners of the classroom.

*In the infant and toddler classrooms CCFS Snodgrass observed mouse droppings and dead spiders along the edges of the wall.

*In the second infant room CCFS Snodgrass observed mouse droppings, dead spiders and roly polys on the floor along the walls of the room.

*In the back toddler classrooms CCFS Snodgrass observed mouse droppings and a centipede.

Based on staff interviews when staff stated that they had seen both alive and dead bugs, hopping bugs, beetles, roly polys and the observation by CCFS Snodgrass when she observed mouse dropping's, dead spiders, ants and a centipede this allegation is substantiated.
