CONCLUSION SUMMARY

SCCR has determined that Twin Pike Family Young Men's Christian Association Inc. violated the above licensing rule based on statements made by Karina Genenbacher, facility director; Denise Ash, program director; Breanna Orf, 2nd grade teacher; Julie Colbert, enrichment teacher; and Andrea Ankrom that on May 2, 2018, Child A was left in the laptop lab while the rest of the class was taken out of the laptop lab to do fire and tornado drills which lasted approximately 2 3/4 minutes. Documentation of the incident was also provided to SCCR.
